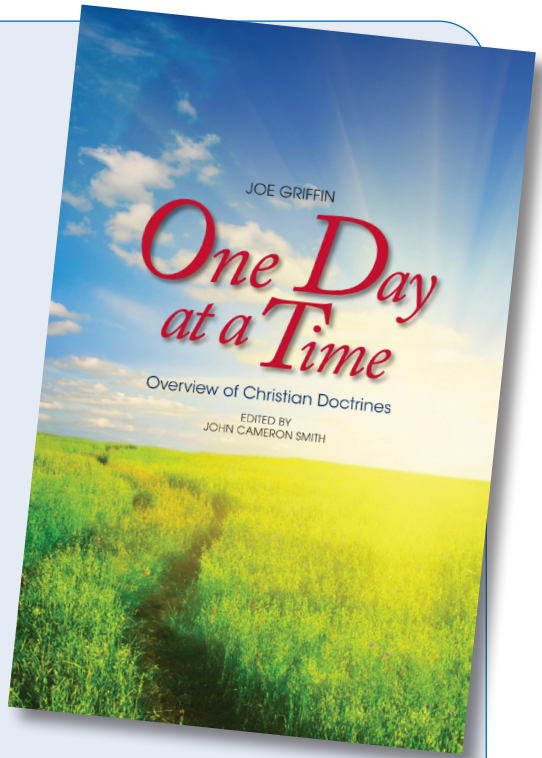
Non-Member Prayer List
