

Divine Dynasphere: Prototype & Operational Power Systems; Power; Objectivity; Teachability: Categories of Humility; Momentum: the Two Royal Commissions

26. The eight categories are described as gates to a power system that is described by two Greek nouns: **δύναμις, *dunamis***: “power,” and **σφαῖρα, *sphaira***: “sphere,” or “power sphere.” From this comes the term Divine Dynasphere. It is made up of eight interlocking gates:

- 1) **Power Gate:** the Filling of the Holy Spirit through confession alone to God alone.
- 2) **Objectivity:** basic Christian modus operandi including rebound, the filling of the Spirit, the faith-rest drill, and a relaxed mental attitude.
- 3) **Teachability:** organizational, enforced, and genuine humility which produces authority orientation.

NOTE: These first three virtues are necessary to learn and apply the doctrines of the Bible in gates four through eight. This chart illustrates what is called the Categories of Humility:

- 4) **Spiritual Momentum:** perception and application of Bible doctrine; skillful use of the first three categories; function as a royal priest and royal ambassador.

NOTE: These latter two expressions of spiritual momentum are the functional areas of fellowship with God and fellowship with man. This chart describes these two commissions:
