

**The Attackers: Human Good & Evil: the Sin Nature Is the Catalyst but Neither Were Judged on the Cross but Were Rejected; Sin Was Judged but Human Good & Evil Continue as Issues in the Invisible War; Human Good Is Lucifer's Attempt to Counterfeit Divine Good**

15. Human good on the other hand is Lucifer's attempt to counterfeit these ingredients. The sinful nature is the catalyst for human good:
- (1) Since the sinful nature is the source of all human good and evil, then all human good and evil must be judged.
  - (2) Only sins were judged on the cross, human good and evil were not judged but remain as the antagonists of divine good in the angelic conflict.
  - (3) However, human good was rejected by the work of Christ since the sinful nature, the source of human good, was judged in Him.
  - (4) This is the impact of the baptism of the Holy Spirit with emphasis on retroactive positional truth. The power of the sin nature was broken at the moment we were placed into union with Christ at salvation.
  - (5) However, since only sins were judged, human good and evil continue as issues in the Invisible War.
  - (6) Since the sinful nature is the source of human good and evil, then Satan must inspire and incite sinful thought, decisions, and actions in order to motivate human good and evil from the soul.
  - (7) Lucifer's strategy is to gain control over the soul of the believer through demon influence so that the believer can be manipulated into performing acts of human good and evil.
  - (8) It is impossible for fallen angels to direct and coordinate the behavior of imperfect people to produce a perfect environment.
  - (9) Therefore, human good and evil are antitheses to the perfect plan of God which is backed by the integrity of God.
  - (10) Although mankind continues to play Satan's game, the production of human good and evil never accomplishes its stated objective.
  - (11) Human good and evil can only offer temporary solutions at best but these solutions usually create an entirely new set of problems for human good and evil to address.
16. The logic of this can be derived by following this line of reasoning: If, when under the power of the Holy Spirit, the believer can only produce divine good, then it follows that when, because of sin, he comes under the rulership and power of the first husband, the only production he can perform must be human good.
17. The carnal believer can only produce works that are mandated by the first husband. Under demon influence these works are designed to promote Lucifer's quest to be like the Most High.
