- 11. A summary of the hatred complex follows:
 - (1) The Sin Nature: The genetically formed sin nature possesses a number of lust patterns: Power: Approbation and inordinate ambition. Pleasure: Areas of gratification that are dishonorable, degenerate, or displeasing to God.

Sexual: Any carnal activity outside the bounds of heterosexual marriage.

Social: The desire to gain a greater social position to the diminishment of others.

Approbation: The desire for praise, approval, and recognition.

Monetary: Obsessive desire to acquire more and more wealth, assets, and possessions. Example: "Parvenu: one that has recently or suddenly risen to an unaccustomed position of wealth or power and has not yet gained the prestige, dignity, or manner associated with it."

Chemical: Use of mind-altering substances that diminish one's ability or desire to comply with establishment or biblical standards for thought, decision, and action.

Crusader: Anti-authority attitudes that either promote or motivate involvement in civil disobedience, globalism, collectivism, environmentalism, terrorism, socialism, communism, anti-Semitism, treason, sedition, rebellion, revolution, or assassination.

Revenge: The desire to retaliate for real or imagined insults, slights, acts, failures, or in current parlance "being dissed."

Criminal: Commission of an act forbidden by law or a duty commanded by law: robbing a bank for the former and not paying your taxes for the latter.

- (2) Negative Volition: Whereas negative volition in the arrogance complex is driven by overemphasis on self rather than interest in God and His Word, in the hatred complex, negative volition is expressed by aggressive assaults on God and His Word. This hatred expands to all things associated with the Christian faith.
- (3) Degeneration: Freedom allows a population to make independent decisions within the confine of the law. For that freedom to be prolonged, the people must use their free will to make decisions that contribute to the maintenance of freedom. Know truth and truth will make you free.
- (4) Antiestablishment: Every system in life has an authority structure. There is policy to maintain order and a process to achieve the desired objective. People have positions of authority to see that the system is maintained. Antagonistic and rebellious people who reject authority contribute to a breakdown of the system. Paul was teaching the divine system in Ephesus but Alexander Coppersmith challenged his authority and that of his message. The divine institutions are the foundation for all authority in life.

(5) Demonism: Lucifer is able to control people by means of demon possession and demon influence. Through them he is able to introduce ideas he hopes will enable him to gain control of the human race through internationalism, collectivism, and multiculturalism.
