D. Biblically Developed Mental Attitudes

I. Spiritual Rapport

- 1. Rapport among believers functions under the royal family honor code which entails the principles of live and let live and avoiding evil thoughts toward others.
- 2. Under the filling of the Spirit, we must love all believers with unconditional love.
- 3. All people sin including ourselves; therefore we must acquire the skill of maintaining a relaxed mental attitude toward all.
- 4. The attributes of honor and integrity are developed from doctrinal thinking which results in true friendships.
- 5. The royal family honor code is found in several passages of Scripture:

Philippians 2:2 - Complete my <u>happiness</u> [PSD #9] by constantly thinking the same things [divine viewpoint], having the <u>same love</u> [esprit-de-corps love 1] concentrating on the <u>same objective</u> [spiritual maturity]. (EXT)

James 2:8 - If, on the one hand, you carry out Operation Royal Law, [1CC: assuming you do], according to the norm or standard of Scripture [Leviticus 19:18]: "You shall love those in your periphery [πλησίον (plēsíon): "neighbor" (NASB)] as yourself," honorably you keep on doing a right thing in a right way. (EXT)

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Leviticus 19:18 -"You shall not take vengeance, nor bear a grudge against the sons of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself; I am the Lord." (NASB)

II. **Grace Oriented Giving**

- 1. Grace giving is not grace giving if you are intimidated, embarrassed, or pressured to pledge or tithe.
- 2. Those that give with the proper mental attitude will always have more to give.
- In the act of grace giving, the believer supplies the 3. proper mental attitude while God supplies the rest.
- In grace giving, the issue is not what you give, but the 4. thinking behind the giving that counts.
- 5. The mentality of grace giving is an expression of free will without gimmicks and without coercion.

2 Corinthians 9:7 -Each person, to the degree he has determined by means of his own soul, so give, not from distress of mind or compulsion of emotions; for God loves a grace-oriented giver." (EXT)

III. Mental Attitude during Evidence Testing

- 1. Subjective thinking under pressure indicates arrogance from self-absorption.
- Undeserved suffering and attacks from the Dark Side 2. demands the mental attitude of objectivity.
- 3. The capacity to think doctrine during normal circumstances should be one's status quo mentality during times of great pressure.
- 4. Preparation for evidence testing comes from a high inventory of ideas from consistent Bible study under the mentorship of a pastor-teacher and the teaching ministries of the Holy Spirit.

Philippians 3:15 -As many as are mature believers, let us continue objective thinking [clarity of thought from doctrine]. In fact, if you have a different attitude in something [from subjectivity], the Lord will reveal even that to you [to your advantage]. (EXT)
