2 Corinthians 11:15 - Therefore, this is not a great surprise if also his ministers are masqueraded as ministers of righteousness, whose end [the Great White Throne Judgment] will be according to their production [purveyors of cosmic propaganda]. (EXT)

2 Corinthians 11 contains a divine analysis of Lucifer's emissaries that are functional in the Church Age. In it, the bad guys are masquerading as the anointed who easily convince the benighted of the validity of their message.

In his first Epistle to Timothy, Paul gives a synopsis of the masqueraders he describes in 2 Corinthians 11:

1 Timothy 4:1 - But the Holy Spirit explicitly communicates that in latter periods of time [between the advents of Christ] some believers will become apostate by revolting against doctrine, paying attention to deceitful spirits [persuasion by the cosmic faculty] and concentrating on doctrines of demons [giving credence to the message and believing its curriculum]. (EXT)

These two passages by Paul provide a spot-on description of present-day masqueraders from the Dark Side.

Under the brilliant direction of Lucifer and his army of fallen angels, a century-long campaign by his "deceitful spirits" has manipulated the mentality of a host of "deceitful human artisans."

Their mission is to propagandize leadership at all levels of our nation, from kindergarten to federal government, by communicating doctrine of demons to the benighted.

This campaign has now reached critical point which we may evaluate under the following points:

1. What Progressives hate is the deification of Jesus. They are willing to use the Lord as a Spokesman for their socialist ideals, but reject Him as God.

2. They are therefore willing to support Jesus as a philosopher, but are in constant combat against Jesus as Savior.

- 3. Class warfare is considered a legitimate tactic to bring competing belief systems into agreement.
- 4. Georg Hegel developed the system of dialectics, or the use of logic to resolve differences between competing philosophies. From this, a progression was developed by Karl Marx that became known as "thesis, antithesis, and synthesis":
 - The thesis is an intellectual proposition. The antithesis is simply the negation of the thesis. The synthesis solves the conflict between the thesis and antithesis by reconciling their common truths, and forming a new proposition.
- 5. An example of "thesis" in this formula would be traditional standards based on establishment viewpoint held by the alleged "oppressors."
- 6. The "antithesis" would be Progressive theories based on socialist viewpoint held by the "liberators."
- 7. As the transformation moves forward, the tension that exists between the two factions reaches "critical point," a "struggle" that includes sedition, revolution, and anarchy versus Draconian laws, martial law, and tyranny.
- 8. In theory, this conflict results in "change," but historically that change, regardless of who wins, is totalitarian in nature.
- 9. Progressives in the United States believe that this "change" can be accomplished, not by the violence usually associated with "critical point," but through rationalism: competing ideas are brought to synthesis, or agreement, through reasoning and argument.

> 10. This is why Progressives support the United Nations, peace summits, and diplomatic relations. When these inevitably fail, they impose a stern wrist slap on the "oppressors," e.g., imposing economic sanctions on Iran which the recent nontreaty entered into by the nation's Secretary of State John Kerry is alleged to be the happy result.

- 11. It is yet to be determined who the next Progressive Paladin will be, but two vying for the title are the epitome of evil in our time: the grift merchant Mrs. Clinton or the boldface Marxist, Senator Sanders.
- 12. Progressives are in a quandary over which would advance the cause fastest and become the best paladin, or champion of their cause. The race is on. Republicans are in the process of choosing who among them would be the best bet to lose.
- 13. Forty years of Progressive propaganda in the government schools is about to pay off ... in a November of the near future.
- 14. The youngest voting demographic – Millennials spanning ages 18–35 – have been thoroughly steeped in globalist thought and are now primed to reflect the shift away from a Traditionalist majority over to a Progressive majority.¹
- 15. How this sad development is quickly taking form is the result of the "long march" that began with gusto in the mid-1960s.
- 16. An excellent description of the transformation of American thought away from capitalism over to socialism is the subject of Patrick Buchanan's book *The Death of the West.*
- Many "conservatives" do not like Mr. Buchanan 17. because he is anti-Semitic. Whether that is true or not is surely up for debate.
