Job 1:22 - Through all this Job did not sin nor did he blame God.

- 82. The most important fact to remember from these applications is that the greatest power available to the believer when resolving the challenges of the Angelic Conflict is the power of the Word of God.
- 83. And all this is made possible by the indwelling of the three Members of the Trinity in the bodies of Church-Age believers functioning inside the bubble.
- 84. The key to consistent and effective use of this power is the mental orientation focused on continued application of problem-solving devices 7 and 8: personal love for God and unconditional love for others.
- 85. The principle orientation in this process is placing number-one priority on one's relationship with God over relationship with people.
- 86. The unique privilege possessed by the Church-Age believer is the availability of divine power through the indwelling of Jesus Christ.
- 87. The continuing historical downtrend in client-nation America means fewer and fewer people ever get out of spiritual adolescence which results in poor relationships with people.
- 88. Churches promote this and, remarkably, so do the political parties in their obsession with social programs.
- 89. PRINCIPLE: The greater the absence of believers' orientation to the power of the Word of God the greater the nation's obsession with secular emphasis on the power of government.
- 90. Because believers do not teach the power of Bible doctrine to their children, there is a consistent erosion of divine thought within the next generation and a consequential shrinking of the pivot.

- 91. The present generation is in all probability the third generation of the four-generation curse.¹ Believers have put the wrong emphasis on people rather than the truth of Scripture.
- 92. Don't misunderstand this. A personal relationship with God and His Word must precede personal relationships with people. It is entirely appropriate to have relationships with people, but that relationship must not preempt one's relationship with God.
- 93. Failure to put doctrine first means there is no significant advance to spiritual maturity and therefore no imputation of escrow blessings.
- 94. To place one's priority on God and learning His Word requires a tremendous amount of effort and time put into the process.
- 95. But God is invisible while people are not. You only see God through His Word. People are visible and you can only discern them through the prism of a Biblical inventory that provides an accurate analysis.
- 96. God is perfect and His Word is alive and powerful. Unfortunately, humans are imperfect, and absent divine viewpoint, have darkened souls and flawed thinking.
- 97. People are genetically blemished and in status-quo adolescence they are benighted and untrustworthy. This requires unconditional love for these people which is frustrating yet necessary for advanced believers.
- 98. Benighted believers are saved, but ignorant of the plan of God and thus live outside the bubble. For them, attendance at serious Bible studies results in great frustration and often rejection of truth.
