**Genesis 3:2** - And the woman replied to the serpent, "From the fruit of the trees of the garden we may eat";

Genesis 2:16 - The Lord God [ יְהוֹהְה אֱלֹהִים (YHWH 'Elohim): Jesus Christ ] commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may freely [ infinitive absolute of בֹּלֻ ('achal): eating ] eat;

v. 17 - "but from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for the day that you eat from it you will surely [ אוֹם (moth): the Qal infinitive absolute: dying spiritually ] die [ אוֹם (tamuth): the Qal imperfect: physically ]."

Genesis 3:3 - "But from the fruit of the tree which is in the middle of the garden, God [ אֱלֹהִים] ('Elohim') ] said, "You shall not eat from it, neither shall you touch it, lest you die."
