

RESPONSE			ACTION
Go away a lot (flee).			Walking forward, eyes on eyes, shoulders square, fingers open, arms out.
Ear locked on: "I'm paying you respect."			Asking for conversation: arms out, eyes on eyes, fingers open; keeping the pressure on.
Making the circle smaller: "I feel safe close to you."			Arms out, eyes on eyes, throwing the line. Keep the pressure on to complete the conversation.
Licking and chewing.			Arms out, eyes on eyes, walking forward, throwing line. "I am asking for more conversation."
Dropping the head: "I'll let you be the chairman of the meeting."			Bring arm down and across the body; eyes still on the horse's eyes. You may slow down.
The horse considers his options: "Should I join his herd? Is he a worthy leader?"			Going passive, eyes down, shoulder at 45°: "Would you like to come in and Join-Up with me?"
"It feels good to be near you. You seem safe."			"You are welcome to Join-Up with me."
"I can't see where you're touching me; I guess I'll trust you."			"Thank you" (reward).
