

We Subordinate, God Protects

future - Imperative; expresses a command. Since a command involves futurity, this form of the verb became an idiom developed from 5th-century B.C. Attic Greek.

Euripides used the form in his play Medea. It indicates a command by means of the tense rather than the mood of the verb.

passive - The believer will become subordinate to God in one of two ways, indirect or direct. In this case the subordination is the result of direct contact with justice under divine discipline.

indicative - Declarative; looks on the action of the verb as a reality in future time. Reversionists with greater reason will eventually subordinate to God in one of two ways.

Hebrews 12:9b CTL - With greater reason, you will become subordinate to ...

pater - “the Father”

The noun, Father, is in the dative case which indicates it is in His interest that our obedience is performed. How is our submission to God's authority in His interest?

Once we are adopted into the Royal Family at salvation, we come not only under God's supervision but we also become His responsibility. Although saved and members of the heavenly *politeuma*, we remain in the hostile environment of the Devil's world.

Even though we are imputed a phenomenal portfolio of divine operational assets, we are not skilled in their utilization and thus unable to successfully defend our souls from the disinformation of the Cosmic Academy.

False doctrine, human good, evil, and human viewpoint predominate the data we are forced to process on a daily basis. Not only are we incapable of properly analyzing its content, we are forced to confront a power which is far greater than we are—the genius mentality of Satan and his demonic emissaries.

Knowing this, God has developed a system by which we may protect our souls from demon influence. By choosing to utilize the assets God imputed to us at salvation, we are empowered with the mental capacity to identify error and reject it. It is in this manner that God protects His children.

It has been said that knowledge is power. If this is true then divine knowledge is all powerful. Thus, doctrine inside the soul converts it into an impenetrable fortress. This occurs when the two power options: (1) the Filling of the Holy Spirit and (2) the Grace Apparatus for Perception, are converted into the three spiritual skills: (1) the filling of the Holy Spirit maintained consistently through rebound, (2) the Grace Apparatus for Perception utilized consistently for spiritual growth, and (3) the 10 problem-solving devices become available for deployment on the FLOT line of the soul. This ensures victory in the Angelic Conflict and thus God's desire is to do all He can to lead a person to this objective.

Therefore, when a new believer fails to utilize his power options, God imposes certain forms of discipline. When the reversionist fails to utilize reversion recovery in order to reactivate the power options and redevelop his spiritual skills, God imposes certain forms of discipline. Why? God loves His children and must find some way to orient, or reorient, them to the only means by which they may survive in the Devil's world.

The power option by which reversion recovery is actually realized is emphasized by the noun used to describe the Father, the genitive plural of: *pneuma* - “spirits.” “the Father of human spirits”
